Mercedes-Benz plant hosts outreach for Tuscaloosa area female students as part of "National Manufacturing Day" initiative

Vance, Alabama – During this year's "National Manufacturing Day" (Friday, October 7th) Mercedes-Benz U.S. International, Inc. (MBUSI) is collaborating with Manufacture Alabama to showcase the types of job opportunities that exist in manufacturing for female students.

Mercedes-Benz Team Members will lead the students in a plant tour on Friday morning, then move the program to the Mercedes-Benz Visitor Center (11 Mercedes Drive) between 11 am and 1 pm for a discussion about careers in manufacturing and specifically at MBUSI. GLAM – Girls Learning Abut Manufacturing – is an initiative of Manufacture Alabama and is designed to create interest in careers in manufacturing amongst the next generation of women in the workforce.

Participating students in the MBUSI / Manufacture Alabama event will come from:

- Tuscaloosa County Schools: Brookwood and Holt High schools
- Tuscaloosa City Schools: Paul Bryant, Northridge and Central High schools

The outreach effort was organized under the umbrella of MBUSI's Diversity and Inclusion Committee, which has implemented a multi-year strategy for the plant. The D&I Committee's "Pink Boots" BRG focuses on topics affecting women in the workplace. MBUSI also has BRGs focusing on Veterans and Early Career Team Members. Special thanks goes to "Pink Boots" Chair, Melody Wilson for organizing the event.
